

Protecting Our County's Water Supply

Nash County is returning to **Voluntary Conservation Stage II** on **August 1**, due to ongoing drought conditions. Residents are encouraged to follow voluntary watering schedules and help reduce peak water demand.

Voluntary Irrigation Schedules:

Water lawns on **Wednesday & Saturday** if you live north of Hwy 64, & on **Thursday & Sunday** if you live south of Hwy 64.

- * **Note for Well Owners:** If your property uses a private well, these guidelines do not apply, as private wells are considered non-public water systems.

Park Sprinklers:

Watering at all Nash County parks and facilities is now limited to three times a week.

Hydrant Flushing:

Routine hydrant flushing is temporarily on hold. Only essential fire-flow testing and flushing of dead-end mains will continue to support public safety.
